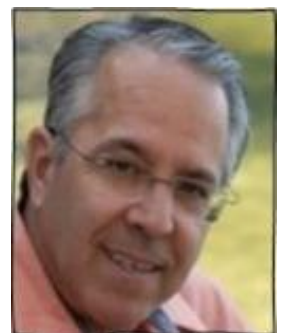
Summer Nights Kickoff: Sundaes on Thursdays!
