INTRODUCTION

Are you interested in developing your faith and growing in your relationship with God and others?

Real Life Ministries offers a process for 7th-12th grade students to increase their ability to apply God's Word and discover how to own their faith.

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OVERVIEW

Vision: To educate, equip, and empower students to reach the world for Jesus one person at a time.

Mission: To create a relational, intentional, and reproducible process of spiritual development.

Target Participants:

- Middle school and high school age students (6th-12th grade)
- Students who participate in the Real Life Youth Groups at the Post Falls Campus
- Students who desire to be stretched and grown in their ability to be a disciple and make disciples.

Time Investment:

- September- May (9 months)
- 4-6 hours per week (See page 4 for more details)

Cost:

The cost of the Youth Development Process will be:

- **HS:** \$150 per semester (\$300 for the year)
- **MS:** \$75 per semester (\$150 for the year)

* This will be due the first day of class (cash, check, or online payments)

**We NEVER want money to be a reason as to why a student is not able to take part in this process. If money is an issue, please talk with us to make a plan for payments or scholarships.*

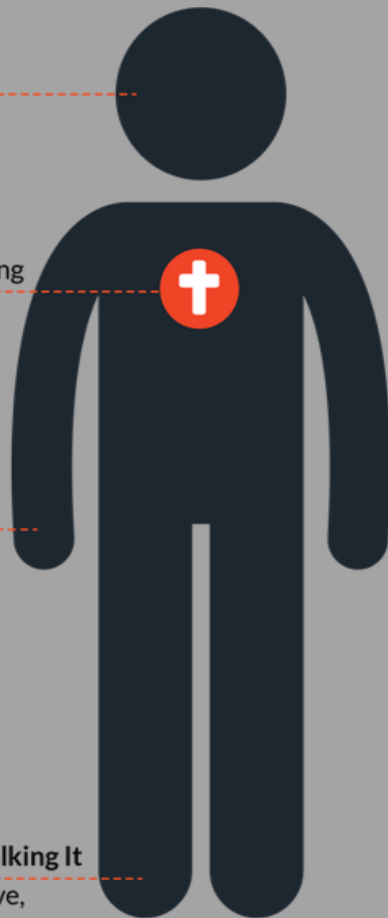

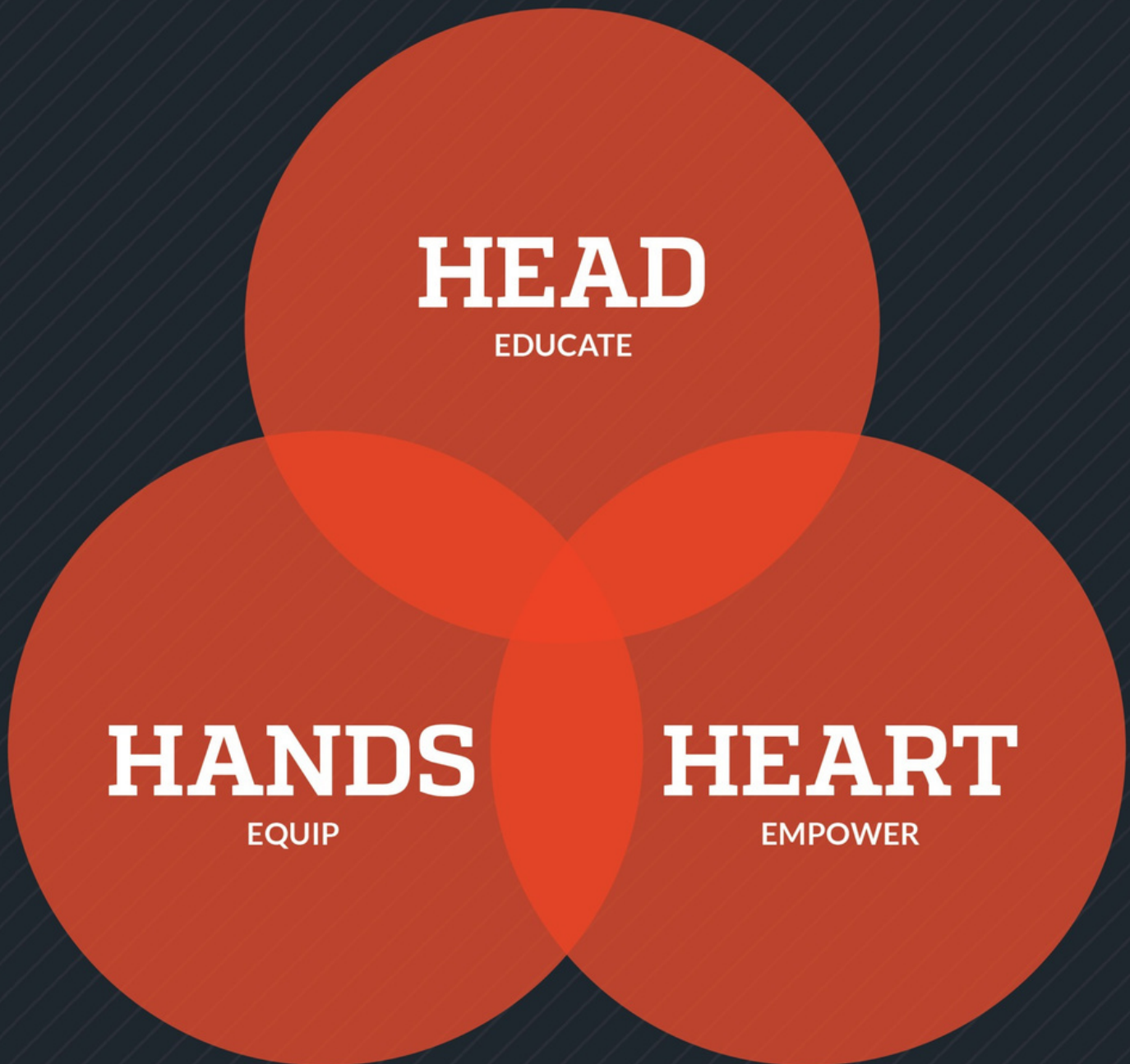

TIME COMMITMENT

The Youth Development Process is a 9-month program that runs during the school year. It is broken into 2 semesters. (Fall Semester: Sept- Dec, Spring Semester: Jan-May).

**We recommend that students commit to a whole year, but we will give students the option to join or drop each semester.*

YOUR ACTIVE WEEK

This is a **4-6 hour a week commitment** broken into 3 components (Head, Heart, and Hands). This is designed to be in addition to your weekend worship service attendance and your youth group and small group participation each week.



Head: You will spend time each week in class learning and discussing content designed to help deepen your relationship with the Lord and to help you Discover, Understand, Own, and Reproduce your faith.

- **Classroom 1.25 Hours**

- Sundays | Room 301
- MS 8 - 9:15 AM
- HS 9:45- 11 AM

Heart: Students will have homework each week to spend time processing what they're learning.

- **Homework ~ 1 Hour**

- **Mentorship 1 Hour Every other week**

(High School Only)

- Each student will be paired up with a mentor who they will meet with every other week to intentionally dig into their personal relationship with God and what He is teaching them.

Hands: Each student will have the opportunity to grow and serve others by being a part of either our Set Up team or Tear Down team at youth group. This gives students time to grow relationally with other students. We also know that an important part of our Christian walk is serving others and Set Up/ Tear Down is a good step in starting this. Students are welcome to be involved in other areas of serving, but this is all that will be required for the YD Process.

- **Ministry Involvement ~2 hours**

- o Set Up/ Tear Down at youth group
- o Times differ depending on MS or HS youth group

Additional Retreats:

- o We will do a retreat in the Fall and in the Spring

EXPECTATIONS

These are the expectations for students in the Youth Development Process:

We expect you to be F.A.T.

- **Faithful:** Choosing to be faithful to God, others, and with our commitments
- **Available:** Choosing to be open to trying new things even if it's outside of our comfort zone
- **Teachable:** Choosing to be humble in recognizing that we can all grow and learn from other people (even broken and jacked up people).
 - **Being humble looks like:**
 - Youth Development is not a "Cool Kids Club."
 - This is an opportunity to serve our peers, and we will not boast in that.
 - We will model what Jesus modeled and humble ourselves as He humbled himself. (*Philippians 2:8*)
 - We will clothe ourselves in humility as Christ commands us to. (*1 Peter 5:5-7; Colossians 3:12*)

We expect you to...

- Attend and participate weekly in a weekend service
- Attend and participate weekly in Post Falls Youth Group and designated small group
- Attend and participate weekly in YDP class; showing up on time with homework done
- Attend and participate bi-weekly in your mentor meeting (HS specific)
- Have Google Classroom and be added to YDP Class
 - Communication, updates, and homework will be shared through Google Classroom
- Communicate to the facilitator and frustrations, concerns, and/or questions when they arise
- Communicate with the right person (facilitator, mentor, ministry lead) whenever you can't make it to any of the previous commitments

EXPECTATIONS



Youth Development Process Code of Conduct

____ I commit to being a godly example to others within my home, youth group, and school/work place. This is shown through respecting those around me by my words, actions, and attitudes. Exodus 20:12; 1 Corinthians 11:1; John 13:35

____ I commit to being faithful in my abiding relationship with God. John 15:5

____ I commit to keeping up with all my YDP obligations (class, serving at youth group, and mentor meetings, etc.)
