

# Communion Server (Volunteer)

## Thursday/Sunday Services

### Role

A communion server provides the sacraments of communion to the congregation.

### Expectation

Volunteers serving in this area provide the elements of communion, unleavened bread and juice, for congregants to participate in the fellowship and remembrance of the Lord's Supper.

Each communion service volunteer is responsible for the following during their service time:

- Arrive early to service to 'sign-up' for a service location at the communion board
- Congregate in the back of the auditorium once the white cross appears on the screen (approximately 45 minutes after service begins)
  - Keep all talking to a minimum so as not to disturb the congregants in service. If you need to ask a question, please move into the lobby to discuss.
- Pass out the elements in your assigned area and scan for any unserved rows or groups as you finish
- Bring trays and carts to the back of the auditorium when completed.

In addition to the service expectations, volunteers are expected to participate in regular training, celebrations, and other ministry events. Volunteers are encouraged to invite new volunteers to join the team by inviting friends, family, Life Group members, etc. to serve with them. If you have a new volunteer for the team, please have them connect with the Hospitality Ministry Lead.

Personal Expectations:

- Membership
- Attend weekly worship service
- Participate weekly in a Life Group
- Maintain a consistent devotional time with God
- Live obediently to God's Word with your time, talents, and resources

### Goal

Every attendee who wishes to partake in communion is served quickly and efficiently while the minister is leading directed prayer.
