

Set-up/Tear-down (Volunteer) Thursday/Sunday Services

Role

Set-up/tear-down evening volunteers create the before-service environment.

Expectation

Volunteers serving in this area set-up and tear-down the lobby and outdoor environments prior to services. This may include: outdoor flag set up, lobby organization, and the table set-up used for evening service dinners. As Moses set up the tabernacle, per God's instruction, to create a space for God's glory to reside, and for the nation of Israel to meet with and glorify God, so do we create a space for the Church to fellowship and glorify God together. Set-up and tear-down is not merely concerned about tables and chairs, but about the environment that is created while utilizing those items.

During their service time, a set-up/tear-down volunteer is responsible for:

- Arriving at the specified time for their specific service.
- Setting up the lobby and outdoor environment (tables/chairs, flags, etc.) before service time.
- Assisting the food service crews as needed with tablecloths, etc. (evening services).
- Having a friendly and joyful demeanor while serving; being intentional to greet guests in the lobby.
- Tearing-down the lobby and outdoor set-ups (evening services) once service begins so that the lobby is 'reset' to its usual appearance before service ends.

In addition to the service expectations, volunteers are expected to participate in regular training, celebrations, and other ministry events. Volunteers are encouraged to invite new volunteers to join the team by inviting friends, family, Life Group members, etc. to serve with them. If you have a new volunteer for the team, please have them connect with the Hospitality Ministry Lead.

Personal Expectations:

- Membership
- Attend weekly worship service
- Participate weekly in a Life Group
- Maintain a consistent devotional time with God
- Live obediently to God's Word with your time, talents, and resources

Goal

Creating a safe, inviting, and loving environment and church culture begins externally with the physical spaces we create and set-up. We pray that the environments set-up are utilized by attendees and members, where they are excited to meet together.
