HOW IS JESUS OUR SACRIFICE?

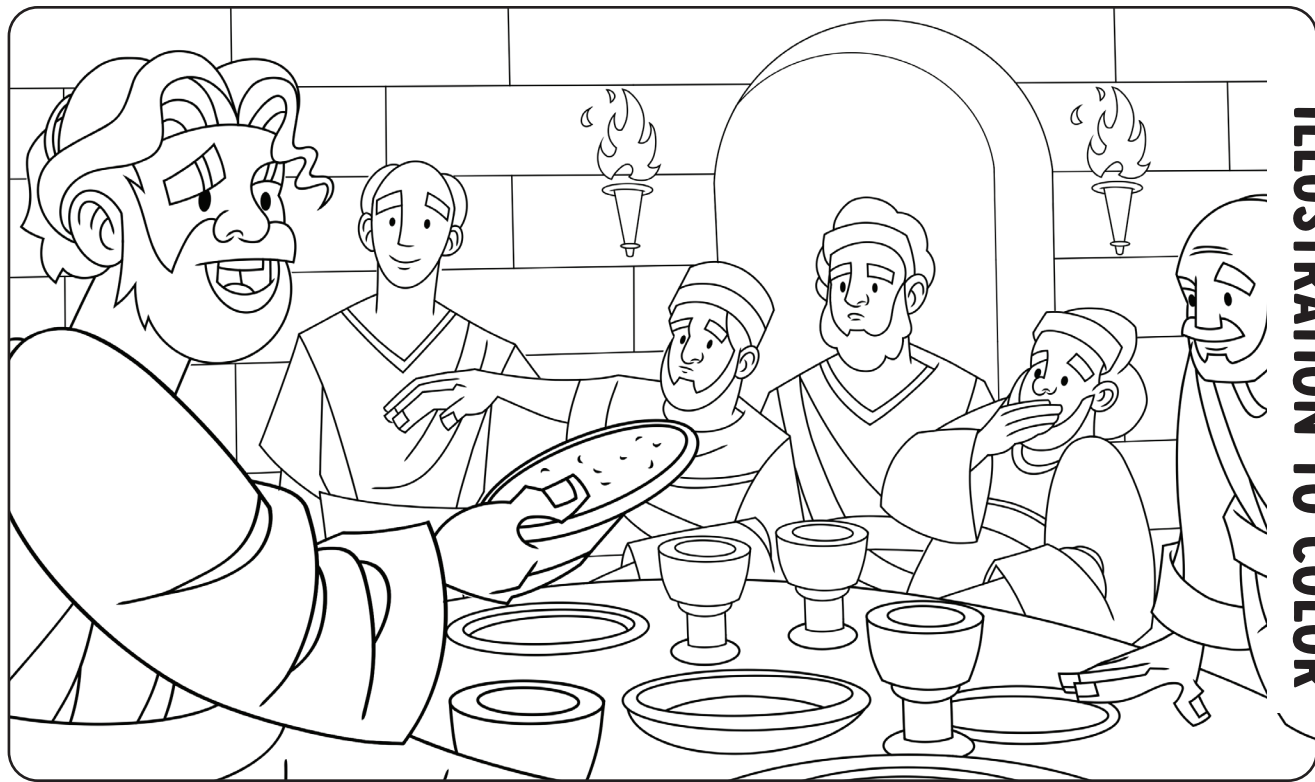
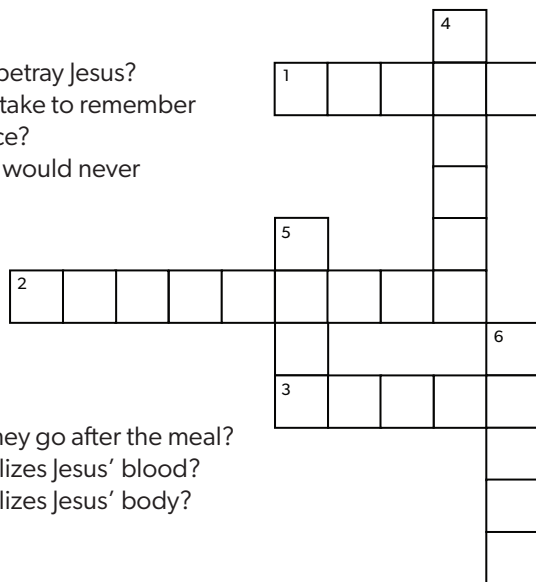


ILLUSTRATION TO COLOR
